### **Kayaking Trip Monday 15<sup>th</sup> August to Friday 19<sup>th</sup> August**

#### **Day 1:**

The kayaks and Supplies etc are loaded onto a mini-barge which takes us to Whitehaven Beach on the south east of Whitsunday Island. We set up camp and spend the rest of the day exploring nearby Haslewood Island and /or Chance Bay on the south of Whitsunday Island. Both these areas boast great fringing coral reefs for snorkelling etc.

#### **Day 2:**

We kayak north along the eastern coast of Whitsunday Island (hopefully with the prevailing south-easterly winds behind us), stopping off at the entrance of Hill Inlet for a swim and a short walk to a scenic lookout. From here we continue north until we reach our camp site at Peter Bay.

#### **Day 3:**

We continue north past Whitsunday Island and follow the east coast of Hook Island to Mackerel Bay. This has to be the best camp site / snorkelling spot in the Whitsundays - has to be seen to be appreciated. This is our camp site for night 3.

#### **Day 4:**

We continue to circumnavigate Hook Island, passing along the northern tip

of the Island, before stopping at Luncheon Bay or Manta Ray Bay for a swim and snorkel. It's then a paddle to our overnight destination, Steens Beach - directly opposite Hayman Island. Once again the coral here is breathtaking.

Day 5:

We paddle across to Bali Hi (Black) Island and Langford Reef before catching the water Taxi back to base at Shute Harbour. Drop off at hotel for hot showers, and dinner before flying home the next day
